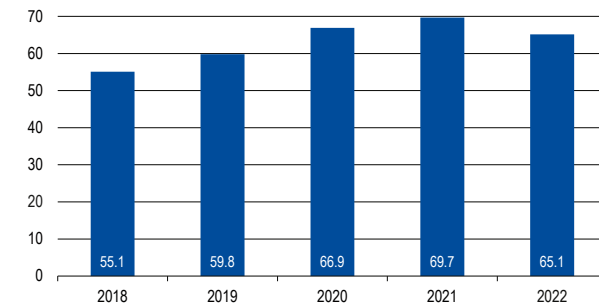

(in millions of Euros)

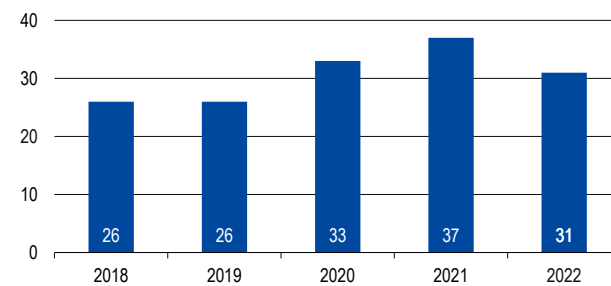

University of Rostock

The University of Rostock (UR) is not only the oldest university in the Baltic Sea region, but also the richest in tradition. Founded in 1419, it looks back on a longstanding history of teaching and research and celebrated its 600th anniversary.

The University of Rostock (www.uni-rostock.de) consists of nine traditional faculties and an additional Interdisciplinary Faculty (INF). The Interdisciplinary Faculty unites scientists and students of all disciplines in four major departments: 'Life, Light and Matter', 'Maritime Systems', 'Ageing of the Individuals and of Society', and 'Knowledge - Culture - Transformation'. These departments represent the key research areas that have developed throughout the long tradition of the University, and contribute to honing the University's profile through connecting its strengths by means of interdisciplinary and cross-curricular cooperation.

Offering more than 150 courses of study (among others 43 bachelor degree courses, 56 master degree courses and 37 state examination courses including teaching degrees), the University of Rostock is one of Germany's Universities with the widest range of academic subjects. Beyond that, its Centre for Teacher Training and Educational Research conducts research on education and works on improving the quality of teacher training.

Mission Statement

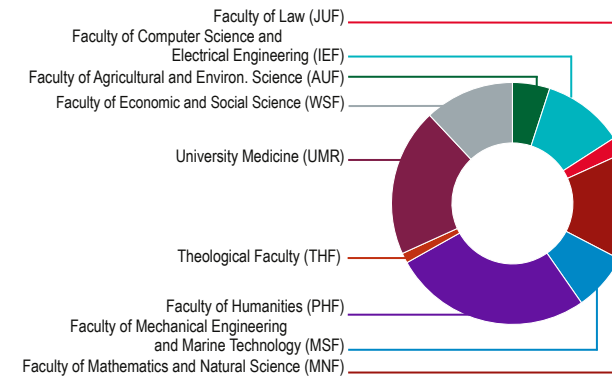

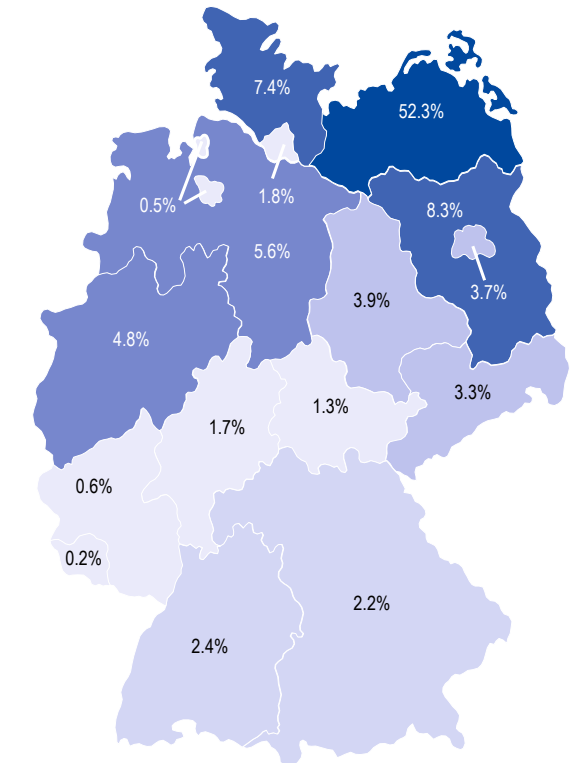
