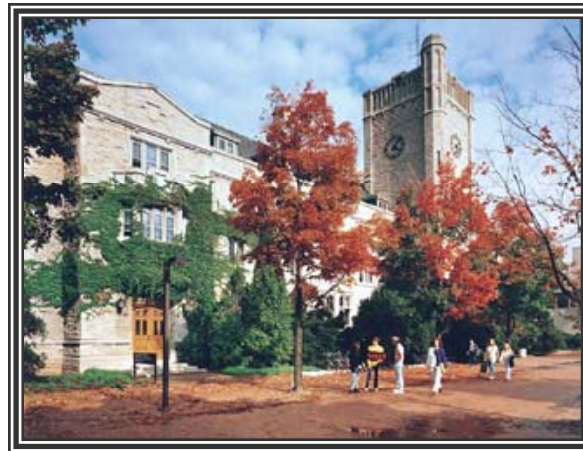


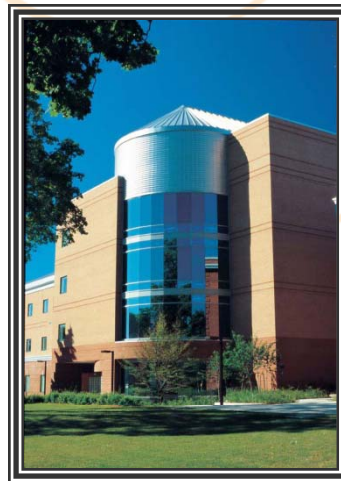

- Guelph is currently ranked as one of the top comprehensive universities in Canada by Maclean's (Canada's news magazine)

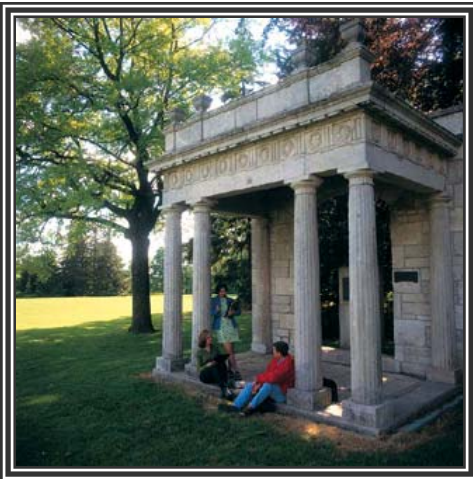

- Campus size: 412-hectares (1,017-acres)



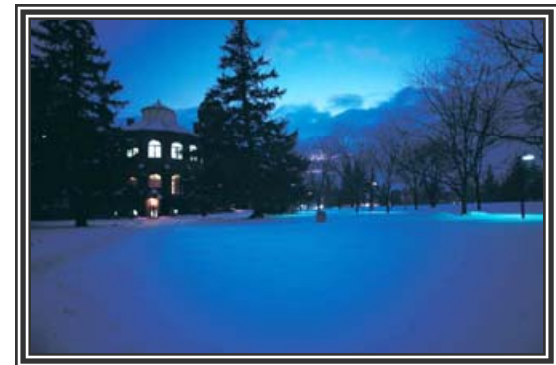
Over 79% of classes at the University of Guelph have less than 50 students

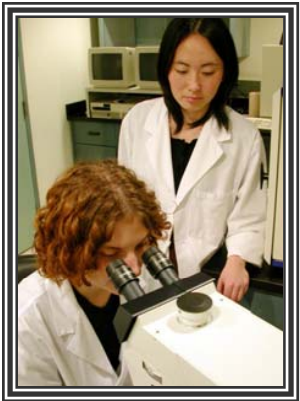

The Centre for International Programs (CIP)

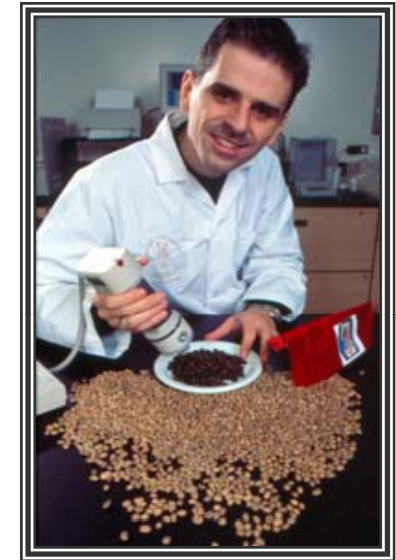
- The Centre for International Programs is centrally located on campus

Early September to mid December

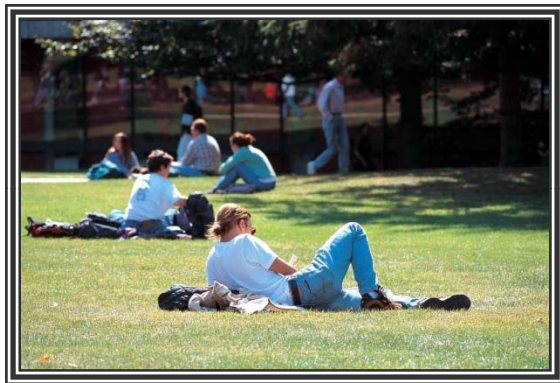
- **Winter semester:**

Early May to mid August

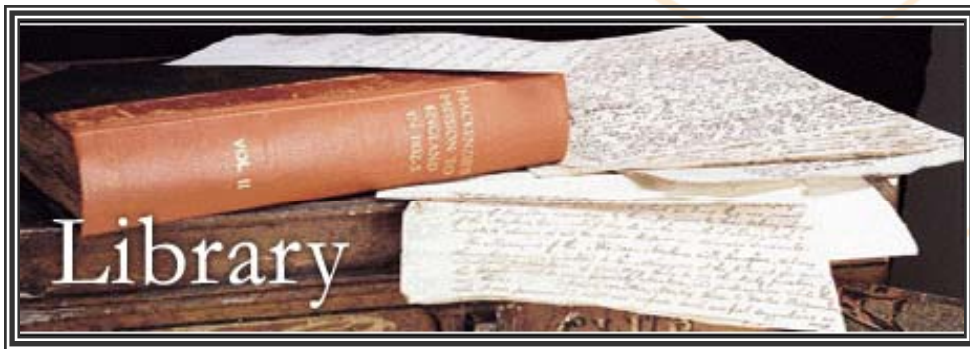
Getting involved on campus



- Over 100 clubs, 2 student newspapers and a radio station
- Two art galleries, a sculpture park, five performance stages
- Over 4000 student jobs on campus
- On campus there are many opportunities to see live theatre, bands, varsity and intramural sports, pubs, political rallies
- Many volunteer and Service Learning opportunities available

The Library

- The library provides support for everyone's research needs, from undergraduate essays to specialized graduate-level investigations
- Access to over 7.5 million items through an automated library system
- 400 computers in the library provide access to books, periodicals, films, audiovisual and archival materials, government documents and maps.



Residence Life



- One of the largest, best established residence systems in Canada
- Exchange students are guaranteed a space in residence if they apply by the residence application deadline
- Residences are spread out across campus – a 5-7 minute walk to anywhere on campus
- 14 Residences that vary in size from 50-500 people
- Most exchange students apply to East Villages Townhouses or International House

Residence Halls

- Most rooms are doubles; some singles available
- Lounges in residence are great for socializing or gathering to watch your favourite TV show – there are also quiet study areas
- Easy access to laundry facilities, kitchenettes and a variety of campus eateries
- Telephone and voicemail, and Internet hook-ups are included in every room – wireless coverage exists through most residences and across campus.



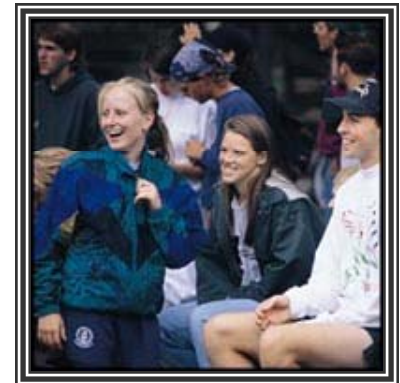
Meal Plans

- Some residences require a meal purchase plan

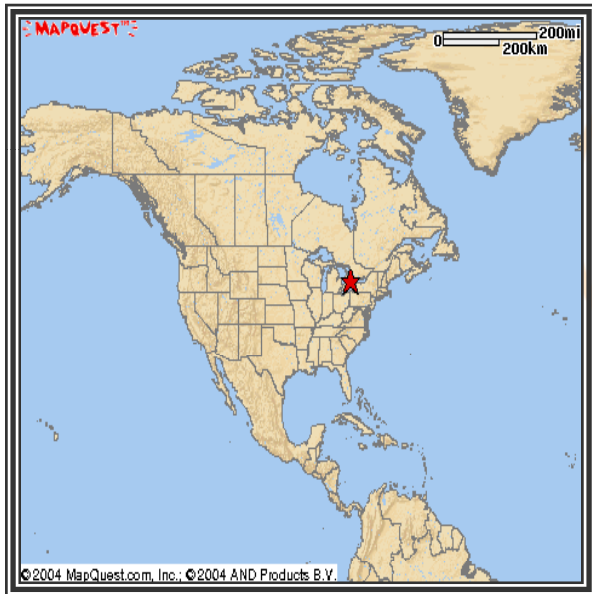


Athletic Facilities
