We encourage applicants with and without a doctoral degree to apply. The positions are to be filled in full-time or part-time.

We offer:

- The successful applicant will pursue his/her academic career with a focus on research and teaching in a multi-faceted, diverse and challenging environment with young and ambitious colleagues.
- You will work on high-quality research with a focus on macroeconomics, both independently and as part of a group. You will present your results on international workshops and conferences and publish in international economic journals. You will be member of an open-minded and cooperative research group that combines quantitative macroeconomic models with statistical and econometric methods (microeconometric and time series analyses) and that values contributing with our research to academic and policy debates.
- You will teach lectures, tutorials and seminars in macroeconomics (teaching load is 4 SWS as a full-time employee). Your responsibilities will include student examinations.
- The position serves for developing your academic career and offers the possibility to obtain a doctoral degree or Habilitation. We support your career by offering the possibility to take part in courses and research stays at national and international institutions.
