

German language courses for refugees in preparation for university enrollment

In cooperation with Study in Germany Rostock e.V., the Rostock International House is consistently offering crash courses on acquiring a German language level (B1.2 to C1). These courses are dedicated to preparing refugees for prospective studies at a German university. All crash courses are to be completed by taking the TestDaF-exam.

German courses starting at A1.1 level can be offered upon request.

All courses may be entered at any time and any language level.

Requirements:

- 1. Intention to apply at the University of Rostock
- desirably some previous knowledge of the German language
- 3. university entrance qualifications
- 4. main place of residence in Rostock or its environs (p.r.n. willingness to move)
- residence on humanitarian grounds, residence permit, suspension of deportation, or residence permit for dependents rejoining family members who have already been recognized as refugees
