LEI (Local Erasmus Initiative)

The LEI is a student group that helps international students to settle in in Rostock and to establish contacts with other people. AStA & StuRa

The General Students' Committee (Allgemeine Studierendenausschuss, AStA) and the Student Parliament (Studierendenrat, StuRa) are the perpetually active lobby groups that campaign on behalf of the student body. The StuRa consists of elected representatives from all faculties, and currently meets twice a month. Each year, generally during the summer semester, willing students can stand for election to the StuRa. The AStA, on the other hand, is made up of students from the most diverse fields of study, each of whom cover their own areas of activity and are available as a point of contact for all students within these fields.
