The lectures and seminars will tackle these questions from various perspectives and will include contributions from medical staff working in the most diverse of disciplines. Key topics will include:

- demographic trends / demographic problems
- specific diseases / problem constellations of elderly people
- strategies and treatment options to deal with (and to some degree solve) these specific diseases / problem constellations
- ethical aspects of medical treatment for the elderly
- technical and medical devices as a support for the aging patient
