Important information

- You need to do a placement test at the Language center and afterwards the registration for the **German class** as it is a mandatory part of your study. (contact person: Ms Stock)
- Health insurance:** Our advice is to enter Germany simply with a travel insurance card and to obtain a proper health insurance only after arrival. In addition, we recommend all students to contract a personal liability insurance and an accident insurance, which includes return transport to your home country (in case of illness or worse). Do not hesitate to consult the Rostock International House regarding this matter.
If you hold a foreign private health insurance card, you need to have it checked by a German insurance company for sufficient coverage (e.g. at the service center of the AOK, Kröpeliner Straße 11)
- You will need a German **bank account** for paying the rent in the dormitory and, if applicable, your health insurance fees. Some banks offer student accounts free of charge. You will receive all related information at Rostock International Office.
- After opening your account, you will have the opportunity to transfer your **semester fee** of 190 Euro to the university account. Please, state your enrolment number, last name and first name on the transfer form.
